This week-long camp will engage students entering grades 1-6 in music, movement, visual art activities and indoor and outdoor games. Each day, participants, who will be grouped by grade level (grades 1-2; 3-4; and 5-6), will rotate through planned activities and scheduled breaks and lunchtime. We'll begin and end each day with a camp-wide gathering in which participants can share experiences and get to know campers in other groups. Weather permitting, we'll take advantage of our proximity to Fletcher-Murphy park (just outside our doors) and spend time in the sunshine. On the afternoon of the final day, we invite family and friends to stop by early and experience the fruits of our time together.

Using different mediums, campers will learn about different art forms and styles and improve their artistic abilities.
